It is a clockwise (orange) or counterclockwise (green) loop ideal for average skiers, often completed in a single day.

- The **Aminta** is located in a **strategic location in Sorrento**. Its location, in fact, not only represents advantages that are typical of a hotel in a **central position in Sorrento**, but it also guarantees tranquillity and breathtaking panoramic views due to its **dominating position over Sorrento**.

Distance from Piazza Tasso

1.5 to 2 km (18-25 m) Downhill (cut thru lemon grove). Tough uphill walk back to hotel

Shuttle Bus (free) 12 passenger, multiple trips within the same hour is possible. The shuttle stop in Sorrento is located on **Via degli Aranci** next to the hotel Cesare Augusto which is a few minutes' walk from Piazza Tasso and the train station

Pompeii and Capri Island (Accessible from Sorrento or Naples, Sorrento is closer proximity)

Free day: Sorrento (individual travel to Capri, Pompeii, or other choices)

Both the train station and ferry terminal can be easily accessed from the Sorrento City Center since the Grand Aminta hotel provides a free shuttle

Pompeii: by train 30-45 minutes Cost \$2.60 to \$5 euros (one way)

For travel in **February**, primary train service: Sorrento and Pompeii is the Circumvesuviana,

Pompeii Stop: Pompei Scavi – Villa dei Misteri (located right next to the ruins entrance)

OR Capri Island

Capri Island: Sorrento ferry terminal

Hotel Aminta shuttle bus stop near **Piazza Tasso** or the main square area. From the drop-off point you can reach the Sorrento Lift port by within 5 -6-minute walk. From Sorrento Lift at Villa Comunale.

Walking: A 10–15 minutes walk downhill or via stairs (~100 steps) from **Piazza**

Feb 11- 14, 2027 Decumani Hotel De Charme, Naples, Italy

Naples, Italy, is famously described as "**Italy in your face**"—a city defined by its raw energy, "intoxicating chaos," and thousands of years of layered history.

1. The Birthplace of Pizza

Naples is globally recognized as the **birthplace of pizza**.

- **Neapolitan Pizza:** Specifically protected by UNESCO, authentic versions feature a soft, chewy crust, San Marzano tomatoes, and mozzarella di bufala.
- **Historic Pizzerias:** Institutions like **L'Antica Pizzeria da Michele** (since 1870) and **Antica Pizzeria Port'Alba** (the world's first, opened in 1830) still serve classic margherita and marinara pies.

• **2. Ancient Ruins & Landmarks**

The city serves as the gateway to some of the world's most significant archaeological and natural sites.

- **Pompeii & Herculaneum:** Ancient Roman cities perfectly preserved by the 79 AD eruption of **Mount Vesuvius**, which still dominates the city's skyline.

- **Naples to Mount Vesuvius**
 - Morning: Mount Vesuvius
 - Train to Ercolano or Pompeii + shuttle
 - Easy hike (~30-40 min) to the crater
 - Incredible view of the bay
 - Afternoon: Vico Equense
 - Relaxing break by the sea
 - **Underground Naples (Napoli Sotterranea):** A hidden city of tunnels, Greco-Roman aqueducts, and WWII air-raid shelters exists 30 meters below the surface.
 - **Castles & Palaces:** Naples is known as the "city of seven castles," with **Castel dell'Ovo** (the oldest) and the star-shaped **Castel Sant'Elmo** being the most iconic.
3. Art & Architecture (Naples)
- **Historic Center:** One of the largest in Europe and a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**, it maintains the original Greek street grid (such as the famous **Spaccanapoli** street).
 - **Masterpiece Sculptures:** The **Museo Cappella Sansevero** houses the world-famous *Veiled Christ*, a marble sculpture renowned for its lifelike transparent-looking veil.
 - **Religious Hub:** Known as the "city of 500 domes," it has more churches than almost any other city, including the **Naples Cathedral**, home to the miracle of Saint Januarius's blood.
- 4. Vibrant Street Life & Folklore**
- **Spaccanapoli & Spanish Quarters:** Narrow, bustling alleys filled with laundry hanging from balconies, scooters, and street food.
 - **Via San Gregorio Armeno:** A world-famous street dedicated entirely to handmade **nativity scenes** (*presepi*) and artisan figurines.

5. Island of Ischia

Interesting heritage and thermal bath possibilities even in winter accessible in 45 minutes by boat from Naples

Typical tour: Ischia from Naples (winter)

07:30 – Departure from Naples

Ferry or hydrofoil from Molo Beverello or Calata Porta di Massa.

Duration: 45 min by hydrofoil, ~1h30 by classic ferry.

Tip: choose the hydrofoil to save time, especially if the weather is good.

09:00 – Arrival in Ischia Porto

Short walk in the port to admire the boats and the winter atmosphere.

Coffee and sfogliatella to start the day off right.

9:30 a.m. – Castello Aragonese

Access by bridge from Ischia Ponte.

Explore the medieval fortress, narrow streets and panoramic sea views.

Recommended time: 1 hour to 1 hour 15 minutes.

Island of Ischia (continued)

11:00 a.m. – Thermal baths / spa

Direction a thermal park:

Negombo Thermal Park (Forio) or

Poseidon Thermal Gardens (Forio)

Enjoy the hot pools, water jets and waterfalls.

Recommended time: 2 hours to 3 hours, possibility to eat on site with a snack or light lunch.

Winter tip: stay inside the pools between the pools if the wind is cool.

2:30 p.m. – Traditional lunch

Recommended restaurants:

Ristorante Il Giardino (Ischia Porto)

Da Ciccio (Forio)

Specialties: coniglio all'ischitana (Ischia-style rabbit), fresh fish, local wine.

4:00 p.m. – Walk and discovery of the village

Walk in Forio or Ischia Ponte depending on the location of the thermal baths.

Discovery of small churches, alleys and craft shops.

Option: if the weather is good, short hike or viewpoint on Monte Epomeo (panoramic view of the island).

5:30 p.m. – Return to Naples

Ferry/hydrofoil return, arriving in Naples around 7:00–7:30 p.m.

Option: have a last coffee or aperitivo in the port of Naples.

Feb. 14, 15, 16, 2027 Rome

Rome is famously called the "**Eternal City**" because the ancient Romans believed that no matter what happened to the rest of the world, Rome would always remain standing. It is one of the oldest continuously occupied cities in Europe and is considered a cradle of Western civilization

1. Iconic Ancient Landmarks

Rome is essentially a "living museum" where 2,000-year-old ruins sit alongside modern life

- **The Colosseum:** The world's largest ancient amphitheater, once home to gladiator battles and public spectacles
- **The Pantheon:** A former Roman temple and now a church, famous for having the world's largest unreinforced concrete dome [
- **The Roman Forum:** The former beating heart of the Roman Empire's political, religious, and commercial life

2. Vatican City

Located entirely within Rome's boundaries, Vatican City is the world's smallest independent country and the spiritual center of the Roman Catholic Church

St. Peter's Basilica: One of the largest and most famous churches in the world

Sistine Chapel: Renowned for Michelangelo's ceiling frescoes, including *The Creation of Adam* and *The Last Judgment* [

• 3. Fountains and Piazzas

The city is known for its "la dolce vita" lifestyle, centered around grand public squares and Baroque art **Trevi Fountain:** A Baroque masterpiece where travelers toss coins to ensure their return to Rome

Spanish Steps: A 135-step staircase that is a popular meeting point and a hub for high-end fashion shopping

- **Piazza Navona:** Known for its stunning fountains, street artists, and outdoor cafes

4. Distinctive Roman Cuisine

While Italian food is famous globally, Rome has its own specific culinary staples

The Four Pastas: **Carbonara** (egg and guanciale), **Cacio e Pepe** (cheese and pepper), **Amatriciana** (tomato and guanciale), and **Gricia**

Street Food: Known for **supplì** (fried rice balls) and **pizza al taglio** (pizza by the slice)

5. Artistic Heritage

Rome houses an incredible concentration of Renaissance and Baroque art. Beyond the Vatican, the Borghese Gallery and [Capitoline Museums](#) contain masterpieces by artists like Bernini, Caravaggio, and Raphael
